



POLICY ON SNOW AND ICE

The car park in front of the Village Hall is used by visitors to the Hall and is also used heavily by parents when delivering and collecting their children from the adjacent primary school. Notices make clear to all users of the car park that they do so at their own risk.

The Village Hall Policy in snowy and icy conditions is not to clear or treat the car park. This is on the basis that any snow or ice hazard should be obvious and that users will naturally take their own precautions in slippery conditions.

The Village Hall is run by volunteers and has no employees. Clearance of the car park would be impractical to undertake and to maintain any partial attempt would be likely to increase the subsequent hazard.

Consideration has been given as to whether in conditions of snow and ice the car park should be closed. It has been decided not to adopt such a policy as this could severely increase the congestion and the dangers to adults and children in the roadway immediately outside the Village Hall and School.

The Village Hall Trust ask the Headteacher of Waldringfield Village School to let parents know of this policy at the start of each winter term.
