In the event of a Fire

DIAL 999

- 1. **The Responsible Person** will instruct all persons to leave the building using the nearest Emergency Exits (not collecting personal items) and to muster together at the Assembly Points (Car park and back lawn).
- 2. Ensure everyone is accounted for.
- 3. **No matter how small the fire, call the fire brigade.** There is a telephone in the office at the hall or use a mobile phone and give this address:

Waldringfield Village Hall, School Lane, Waldringfield IP12 4QP

- 4. **The responsible person** should ensure that once the Village Hall has been evacuated, no one re-enters the hall to collect personal belongings etc.
- 5. On the arrival of the Fire Brigade, **the responsible person** should report to the officer in charge and should advise them whether any persons are missing.
- 6. Attempts to extinguish the outbreak of the fire should only be carried out if it is safe to do so. If there is any doubt, get out of the building.
- 7. If possible once the circumstances allow, and after carrying out the above please call one of the key holders.

A full list of key holders is on the notice board beside the main entrance.

Note all incidents, no matter how small, should be reported to a member of the Management Committee and noted in the incidents book in the main lobby.
