



WALDRINGFIELD VILLAGE HALL TRUST LOTTERY TERMS AND CONDITIONS

What is the Lottery for?

The Village Hall Lottery is a monthly lottery to raise money for the maintenance and improvement of Waldringfield Village Hall.

How is it governed?

The lottery is registered by East Suffolk Council as a 'Small Society Lottery', Registration Number L&A1161

What are the prizes?

Five cash prizes are awarded each month. These are calculated using about 50% of the value of the tickets sold in the proportion approximately:-

1st prize 34%; 2nd prize 26%; 3rd prize 19%; 4th prize 12%; 5th prize 9%.

How much goes to the Village Hall?

In a typical month about 50% of the value of the tickets sold will go towards the maintenance and improvement of the Village Hall, the only costs deducted being the prize fund and the licence fee. This compares favourably to the statutory minimum of 20%.

When are the draws?

The monthly draws are normally held on the first Thursday of every month at the Village Hall coffee mornings, starting in July and ending in June.

How can I enter?

The monthly lottery runs from July to June each year and each ticket for entry into the monthly draw costs £1. It therefore costs £12 for one entry for each and every month of the lottery year. Payment can be by cash, bank transfer, cheque or standing order. Collectors collect £12 subscriptions in the June before the July draw.

Only tickets that have been paid for at the time of the draw can be entered into the draw.

How will I know if I have won?

The winning tickets are announced each month at the Waldringfield Village Hall coffee mornings and details are also posted on 'Waldringfielders'. Cash prizes will be paid by cheque and will be delivered to the winners using the information supplied to us.

General

Tickets can only be sold by persons aged over 16 years to persons aged over 16 years. Cheques which have not been cashed six months after a winning draw will be cancelled and the money treated as a charitable donation to the Village Hall. In the event of a pandemic or other extraordinary event, the draw may need to be suspended or other arrangements made. Personal data is kept only for the purposes necessary for the Lottery.
